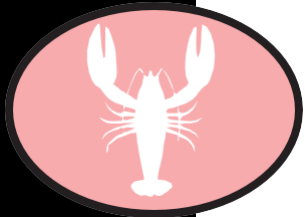

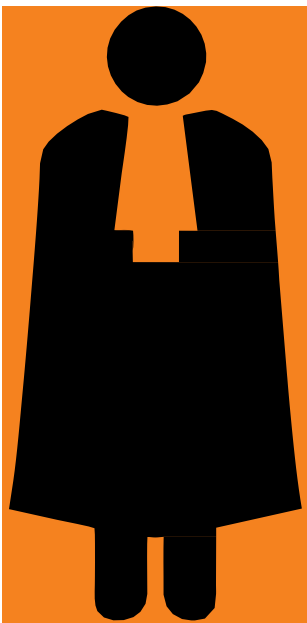

crawfish production

...our operations are based in the following farms:

1. 5 Acres Farm located at Tulimani, Mbooni, Makueni County (about 80 Km from Nairobi City Centre)
2. 2 Acres Model Farm Located at Katoloni, Machakos Town (about 65 km from Nairobi City Centre)
3. 60 Acre Kitil Farm Located at Isinya, Kajiado county (About 60km from Nairobi City Centre)

These farms are used for crawfish production, crawfish fry/hatchery/nursery production and brood stock selection using pond, dam and aquaponics system.



Kisumeo Organics Company Limited operates across multiple aquatic value chain. i.e. crawfish farming, shrimp/prawn farming and lobster farming.

Crawfish production is the flagship for the time being;

The main products from crawfish farming are:

- Fresh/live crawfish
- Frozen whole crawfish & crawfish tails
- Brood stock from selective breeding
- Craylings/fries from the hatchery
- Research & Development of Crawfish XY genome

PRODUCTS PROCESSING & PACKING

Kisumeo Organics Limited tends to process farm products in the process of value addition to the farm produce, whereby;

- Crawfish flesh is processed to crawfish powder
- Crawfish shells are repurposed and processed to livestock feed.

TRAINING, CONSULTANCY & EXTENSION SERVICES

Kisumeo Organics Limited facilitate links to both formal and Informal training as well as extension services specifically to esteemed customers who purchase brood stock/fries from the company and contracted farmers. These customers are treated as potential future suppliers of crawfish to the company.

The training involves

- Pond, dam & aquaponics system design
- Handling of eggs and fries
- Hatching of eggs and larvae management
- Feeding and feed formulation
- Juvenile & grow out management
- Maintenance of production system i.e. ponds, dam and aquaponics system

Kisumeo Organics Limited invests on securing a reliable market for the aquatic products produced within the company as well as those products produced by out growers within the franchise system

franchise system

Kisumeo Organics Limited manages a list of out growers who produces crawfish for crawfish powder through our buy back agreements for small holder farmers in the franchise system.

logistics

Kisumeo Organics Limited manages the storage and transportation of produced up country to Isinya for processing and value addition.
