


















The Main Mission

Its main mission is to manufacture and market cereal products (fortified millet flour, precooked fonio, monicourou, diouka, etc.) that are healthy and ready to be consumed. Its products are marketed throughout the African sub-region, in France and in the USA.

Céréales de Tatam has a production capacity estimated at three hundred (300) tons per year and employs about thirty (30) people. It also has a production unit that enables it to meet an average demand of 5 tonnes per day for all cereals.
