Faso Kaba was set up to contribute to food self-sufficiency through the production and marketing of improved seeds. In 1985, during my stay in the United States, I had the opportunity to work with Garst-Seed, a seed company in Ames, Iowa. This experience helped me to understand that it was possible to get better yields by using quality seeds. As the daughter of farmers, I could see all the effort my mother put into working the land and the low yields that resulted. It all started with this thought, and in 2007 Faso Kaba was born, the first private seed company created and managed by a woman in Mali.

≻ Its objectives:

- ✓ Produce and distribute quality, improved agricultural seeds;
- ✓ Increasing farmers' access to quality inputs, including seeds;



> Faso Kaba specialises in :

- production and distribution of agricultural seeds, inputs and equipment, with a network of over 200 producers organised into cooperatives;
- innovation and creating demand for improved variety seeds (5 sales outlets and a network of over 150 agro-dealers, setting up demonstration plots and guided tours, fairs and promotional days);
- Raising awareness, informing and training farmers about agricultural seeds;

Qualité,

- Accessibility of agricultural inputs (fertilisers, improved seeds, etc.) close to farmers in appropriate packaging at affordable prices.
- Seed quality assurance (2 seed cleaning and conditioning lines)
- ✓ Faso Kaba distributes agricultural seeds and other inputs to the government, programmes and projects, individual producers, producers' organisations (Pos) and also outside Mali (Sierra Leone, Senegal, Liberia, Gambia, Syria, Jordan and Guinea).







Job creation

- ≻ Faso Kaba SARL employs :
- 25 permanent jobs, 90% of which are for women and young people, and more than 100 indirect jobs in its packaging units, farms and sales outlets,
- A network of 200 out-growers,
- Gender promotion

- For plant breeding




