



Purpose of the OECD-FAO Agricultural Outlook


- Not a forecast
 - Strict assumptions
 - 10 year horizon
 - Projections based on modelling and global expert input
 - Global coverage
 - Detailed chapters for all major commodities
- Understanding linkages
 - Closing of balances
 - Feed, Processing
- Policy planning & discussion
 - Scenarios
 - Impact assessment








Global use of major commodities



Crushing of oilseeds is not reported as the uses of 'vegetable oil' and 'protein meal' are presented; Dairy refers to all dairy products in milk solids; Sugar biofuel use refers to sugarcane and sugar beet, in sugar equivalent



Low and middle-income countries drive food demand growth




Dairy is measured in milk solid





Growth in crop production driven by growth in yields








Trade is essential for global food security


Imports as a share of total calorie availability








Continuing downward trend in real prices







Per capita availability of fruits and vegetables in selected regions, 2016-18






World major tropical fruit outlook: Global exports
