CAHFSA

- CARICOM Stands for Caribbean Community and Common Market and is defined as an organization made up of 15 Caribbean nations to promote economic integration among members.
- Officially established on August 1, 1973, through the signing to the Treaty of Chaguaramas
- In 2001, a revised treaty of Chaguaramas helped pave the way for the Caribbean Single Market and Economy (CSME)





CAHFSA

OBJECTIVES

- Establish an effective and efficient regime of Sanitary and Phytosanitary (SPS) measures in support of the community's agriculture policy
- Provide support regionally and nationally in the establishment, management and operation of their national agricultural health and food safety systems
- Execute on behalf of those countries such actions and activities that can be more efficiently and effectively executed through a regional mechanism......





<u>CAHFSA – CORE FUNCTIONS</u>

- Promotion of development and use of regional and international SPS measures, standards and guidelines
- Strengthening of legislative framework with respect to SPS measures
 - Area of deficiency need for new and upgraded legislation and regulations
- Monitoring and Evaluation of national programmes in relation to animal health, plant health and food safety







- Harmonization of technical procedures in relation to such matters as:
 - Quarantine systems and their protocols
 - Surveillance
 - Laboratory analyses:
 - Another area of deficiency countries where no SPS laboratories are functional or have minimal operations
 - Where present, lack qualified, trained staff, have high turnover rates in some cases
 - Problems in acquiring and maintaining accreditation.
 - Safe management and use of agrochemicals and other chemical inputs (antibiotics)



Cont'd

- Development of protocols for the conduct of regional and international risk assessments
 - In the process of planning the conduct of Regional Risk Analyses for Poultry products in five Poultry producing countries
 - Development of regional harmonized protocols for conducting Pests Risk Analyses (PRAs)
- Development and Maintenance of Regional and National databases
 - Import and export requirements for Animals and Animal Products, Plants and Plant Products; Disease Prevalence, Trade Issues in the Region; Animal and Plant Health Expertise; Regulated Pests





Cont'd

- Provide Information
- Produce guidelines
- Prepare "tech packs" for Value Chains
- Assist with development of local SPS systems/bodies to meet obligations in a timely and efficient manner
