Problem	 High stunting rates (37.1% compared to 29.3% in SA Region)
Solution	 Orange Fleshed Sweet Potato; Biofortified VitA: (Flour & Puree)
Nutrition Impact	■ 900,000 HH in 2024 from 680,000 in 2023
Market Value	■ Estimated US\$60.0m: Goal: to reach 2% of market share by 2027
Business Model	 Designed for today, for tomorrow (Built for a circular economy)
Traction	 6,000 SH farmers trained since 2017. 600 under contract farming
Competition	Own factory; Partnerships; full certification; Packaging
Marketing/Sales	Electronic/print media; word of mouth; social platforms; Wsale
Management	 4 Professionals (24 Fulltime); 400 Seasonal (80% women)
