Circularity of minerals Traceability of carbon extracted from the atmosphere through photosynthesis

- Over 3 million tonnes per year of carbon generated as a by-product of the agro-industry:
 - Cocoa shells or empty pods
 - Cashew nut shells
 - Oil palm raffia and fibres
 - Rice husks
 - Cassava peelings and fermentation liquid
 - Cotton stalks
 - Corn cobs












The solutions implemented by LONO in its activities

- 1. Population growth: Work with aggregators once the model has been validated and share revenue to achieve scale as quickly as possible
- 2. Climate change: Incorporate recycling and carbon reduction opportunities into their business models and forge partnerships for certification.
- 3. Widespread soil depletion: Test and familiarise yourself with the comparative advantages of agroecological practices. Production of compost, biochar, digestate, addition of mycorrhizal fungi and other beneficial fungi.


Fruit production plots applying compost and biochar in Yamoussoukro and Korhogo
